Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As-Salaamu 'alaykum wa Rahmatullaahi wa Barakaatuhu.

Last month we told you that we had <u>closed the deal and taken possession of the site</u>, <u>Alhamdulillah</u>. In this update we will give you a brief status update about site improvements and personnel recruiting.

<u>Site Update</u>

As stated last time, we are going to be working on the site in two phases. Phase 1 will be the short-term solution where we will occupy approximately 12k sqft in the building, and in Phase 2 we will re-purpose the entire building after the tenants leave in about 1 year.

In terms of progress on Phase 1, we have submitted the plans to the city, and have received approval from most of the departments. We are still targeting to complete the physical work (paint, carpets, HVAC, A/V, etc) to allow us to start basic operations in late February.

We will send out an update in mid-January regarding the status of the improvements, and will also give an indication of the Ramadan plan, Insha Allah. As stated last time, given the work required, and the presence of tenants on-site, <u>please do not drive into the parking lot or walk into the building</u> <u>uninvited</u>, <u>until we send out a notice in February indicating the start of operations</u>.
